Maastricht, 22 January 2026 – Kruisherenhôtel Maastricht today announces the start of a special collaboration with internationally renowned landscape designers Piet Oudolf and Tom de Witte for the creation of a completely new Cloister Garden and Courtyard. The renewal is part of the room renovation and sustainability programme of the Kruisherenhôtel, set to begin in August 2026. The five-star Kruisherenhôtel, part of Oostwegel Collection and located in a 15th-century monastery, is known for its unique blend of history, design, and hospitality. With the addition of a redesigned cloister garden and courtyard, the hotel aims to offer guests and visitors an even more meaningful experience, where tranquility, nature, and architecture come together.

Piet Oudolf, globally recognised for iconic projects such as The High Line in New York and the planting designs of Millennium Park in Chicago, brings his vision on biodiversity and seasonal expression to Maastricht. His signature planting style creates a dynamic, natural look that remains appealing throughout the year. Oudolf collaborates with **Tom de Witte**, a garden and landscape designer specialising in contemporary gardens where planting plays a central role. Tom has been Oudolf's right-hand man for many years, working together on projects both in the Netherlands and abroad. They will create a garden design and planting scheme that fully aligns with the style and quality of the Kruisherenhôtel.

Camille Oostwegel, Owner & Managing Director of Oostwegel Collection, is particularly proud of the partnership: "With this project, we are creating a place where history, art, and nature reinforce one another," says Camille Oostwegel. "The new garden will not only inspire our guests but will also contribute to the greening of Maastricht's city centre."

The renovation of the Kruisherenhôtel, including the creation of the new courtyard and Cloister Garden, will take place in phases and is expected to be completed by December 2026. Oostwegel Collection will share more information about the project in the coming months.
